



COVID-19 VISITOR VACCINATION POLICY

November 10, 2021

As part of VGH & UBC Hospital Foundation's commitment to the health and safety of our community, including our healthcare partners and donors, the Foundation has implemented a COVID-19 vaccination policy for Foundation staff which requires all employees of the Foundation to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19. As of November 10, 2021 this policy will also be extended to all visitors to the Foundation's offices and to visitors that Foundation staff meet with at other VCH sites.

To verify vaccination status, visitors will be required to show their BC Vaccine Card (or equivalent) and photo ID to the greeter at the entrance to the Vancouver General Hospital or other VCH site. We will not be collecting or storing proof of vaccination.

Vancouver Coastal Health will be checking for vaccination status when you arrive at a VCH site. Please have your BC Vaccine Card (or equivalent) and photo ID ready to show the greeter at the entrance. The Foundation will not be requiring visitors to provide proof of vaccination separately on entry to the Foundation offices.

Effective date and duration

This vaccination policy will come into effect on November 10, 2021, and will remain in effect as long as necessary based on recommendations and guidance, and orders issued by the PHO. The policy will also be updated and amended as needed.
