Mike McCardell is a well-known Vancouver figure, recognized for his CTV broadcasts on human interest stories and for writing a litany of best-selling books. Mike has made a career out of finding and sharing the "heart" in everyday life, highlighting the moments around us we often take for granted.

Mike never would have guessed that one day he would become the story.

"One day I started to feel dizzy, sweaty and overall not well," says Mike.

Mike did his best to get the day's story finished. He was holding onto his chair until they completed editing, and afterwards he drove out to pick up his wife from work. It was there a colleague of his wife's took one look at him and told him to get into the car and that they were going to the hospital.

On the steps of UBC Hospital, Mike suddenly collapsed.

Drs. Graham Wong and Noah Alexander, along with the expert team at UBC Hospital, resuscitated Mike. But his fight for life continued.

Mike was transferred to VGH for their expertise in intensive care joining **3,000 other patients from across BC** who are admitted into the Cardiac Intensive Care Unit every year. He was placed into an induced coma, and had his temperature regulated by a targeted temperature management machine. With the health care team able to access critical donor-funded devices such as cardiac defibrillators, telemetry packs, electrocardiography MIKE AND DR. GRAHAM WONG

machines, regulators for heart and lung machines and more, Mike was given world-class care right here in Vancouver. A few days later he woke up, stable and recovering.

These days, Mike feels safe again as the medical team at VGH surgically implanted a defibrillator to keep his heart in check. Despite his neardeath experience, Mike is as healthy as can be. He's forever grateful to have a second chance at life.

Thanks to your monthly gifts, experts at both VGH and UBC Hospital had the equipment, facilities and resources to meet Mike's heart attack head on. They delivered unparalleled care from the second Mike arrived, saving his life, because of people like you.

ADVANCING CANCER TREATMENTS

VGH is the provincial centre for the treatment of blood cancers and blood diseases, annually caring for approximately **100 new patients with** acute leukemia and performing 200 bone marrow transplants. These are adults who need the best, most advanced care and treatments. flving in from as far as the Yukon to the Leukemia/Bone Marrow Transplant Program (L/BMT) at VGH. Your gifts supplied \$706,000 to the BMT Education Project, \$100,000 to a minimal residual disease study in acute myeloid leukemia, \$45,000 for equipment in the apheresis unit, bursaries for specialized nursing courses, and more.



RESTORATIVE REHABILITATION

At GF Strong Rehabilitation Centre, a remarkable team of specialists help a wide spectrum of patients, annually admitting more than 500 inpatients and providing 20,600 clinic visits annually. These are individuals who are often re-learning how to do basic human functions after suffering from disease or injury. Walking, talking, eating, standing, sitting—foundations many of us take for granted—are restored here. Your donations supplied this team with a \$55,000 Bioness System which stimulates muscles and helps restore functionality for all GF Strong patients in need of physical rehabilitation.



MATERNAL CARE IN THE DTES


Thanks to your inspired and visionary philanthropy, Sheway is providing vital services to pregnant women and new mothers who are struggling with substance use disorders in Vancouver's Downtown Eastside (DTES). Prior to Sheway's launch, one in two babies born in the DTFS were substance-affected and **one-third** had a low birth weight. Today, **most** children born to Sheway clients have normal birth weights and most new mothers are able to care for their children at home. Your gifts totalling \$10,000 to this program purchased vital signs monitors and digital baby scales in support of patient care.
